- (2) A final scientific report on the activity should be submitted to the co-chairs of VarSITI and the SCOSTEP Secretariat within 30 days of completion of the activity. The final report will eventually appear on the VarSITI website and newsletters. The report for the VarSITI newsletter should have less than 150 words with one figure/photo with caption. If agreeable, the writer's small face photo is also added.
- (3) A financial report including the breakdown of expenses should be submitted to the SCOSTEP Secretariat, Dr. Marianna Shepherd (mshepher@yorku.ca) within 60 days of completion of the activity.
- (4) The support by VarSITI should be acknowledged in the database website.
